### **APPLICATION DEADLINE**

NDSCS doesn't have an application deadline, but some programs do fill up quickly. The sooner you submit your application, the better your chances are for getting into your program of choice.

#### **ADMISSION CHECKLIST**

- ☐ Apply Online and Pay the \$35 Application Fee
- ☐ Share Your Official High School Transcript or GED

An in-progress transcript must be submitted to make an admission decision. An official high school transcript with final grades and a graduation date is required upon completion of high school.

Transfer students who have earned an Associate or higher degree do not need to submit high school transcripts.

#### Share Official College Transcript(s)

Transfer students, and students taking coursework at colleges or universities while enrolled in high school, must submit official in-progress transcripts. Final college transcripts must be submitted once all course work is completed.

#### Optional: Report Your Test Scores

Students are not required to provide test scores (e.g. ACT, SAT, ACCUPLACER) - but they help with placement into required courses. For more information about entrance scores for your selected program and ACCUPLACER testing options, visit NDSCS.edu/TestCenter.

#### Submit Any Sponsorship Paperwork

Certain programs require sponsorship documentation before you are fully admitted. To learn more about Sponsorships visit NDSCS.edu/Sponsorships.
