- Matt Schur, Student and Residential Life Director
  - Here to address the changes of the bathrooms outside the dining hall. Have gotten a better understanding of why it was done and can explain it to us. Sometimes organizations will rent out facilities and they can make special requests. One request was to have gender neutral bathrooms available for them. After this event, our inclusion desires were evaluated by the executive directors. There was a request and the desire to have gender neutral facilities here on campus. It was oppted to make it permanent instead of tempory. The area was chosen because the other bathrooms by the IT Department, don't have doors and it was more cost effective to have doors put in. The fairest way to go about this was to use the bathrooms by dining hall. A lot of what needs to be done as administratives for students is to have a private place for individuals to find comfort. There may be a desire to renovate this building and have single use bathrooms. It is believed that this building has already been on the agenda for change. In future, the renovation of this building could happen, but right now, we don't have the facilities to add another bathroom and make it the gender neutral bathroom. We will make sure that our facilities are in a fair, safe, and comfortable place and that happens to be in this building. It's not a convenient set up but it's the most cost effective. The signage on the doors needs to be changed. The decision of the bathrooms was not communicated with the students and the executive directors recognize that they need to give their voice along with listening to students.
