




In either case, the courses will transfer between listed institutions and will fulfill general Psychology, pre-requisite, and/or Psychology requirements as annotated in the attached agreement.
2. This agreement is in force from the date of its approval and will be formally reviewed by the Psychology Academic Discipline Group every other year. All signatories will have the right to continue, amend, or cancel their involvement with this agreement at that time.
