Colleagues –

Based on new guidance from the [NDDoH](#) and the CDC, employees and students (**not** living in residence halls) and are **fully vaccinated** (>2 weeks following last COVID-19 vaccination) will **NOT need** to quarantine if identified as a close contact to someone who tests positive for COVID-19.

This change **does not impact students living in Residence Halls** due to their congregate living designation.

Students and employees are **still expected** to report to the College through the [NDSCS COVID-19 Reporting Form](#) if they have been a close contact. If seeking exemption from quarantine status, individuals will be required to provide documentation of vaccination status.
