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NDSCS Faculty and Staff –

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 situation, NDSCS will continue to utilize Distance and Online Learning delivery methods for the 1<sup>st</sup> 4-week (June 2 – 26) and full 8-week (June 2 – July 24) Summer Session classes. The 2<sup>nd</sup> 4-week Summer Session (June 29 – July 24) will include a limited number of face-to-face class offerings.

Important Notes:

- Students already registered for face-to-face, on-campus classes during the first 4-weeks and/or full 8-week summer session will be contacted by the Academic Program Support office.
- Courses that were originally scheduled to be taught online will continue as scheduled.
- Other experiential-based courses (e.g. Co-ops, internships, SOE's, clinicals, field experiences) will continue as scheduled.

In addition to the Summer 2020 session courses, NDSCS will also be conducting a three-week Technical Skills Session from August 3 – 21. This three-week, on-site instructional period is an opportunity for selected departments to schedule intensive hands-on instructional sessions so students may receive technical instruction that was missed during the last portion of the Spring 2020 semester. Students will work closely with advisors/faculty members to further understand/select this option. Students participating in the Technical Skills Session will have the option to live and eat on campus for a nominal fee; more information about this will be available to students after May 1.
