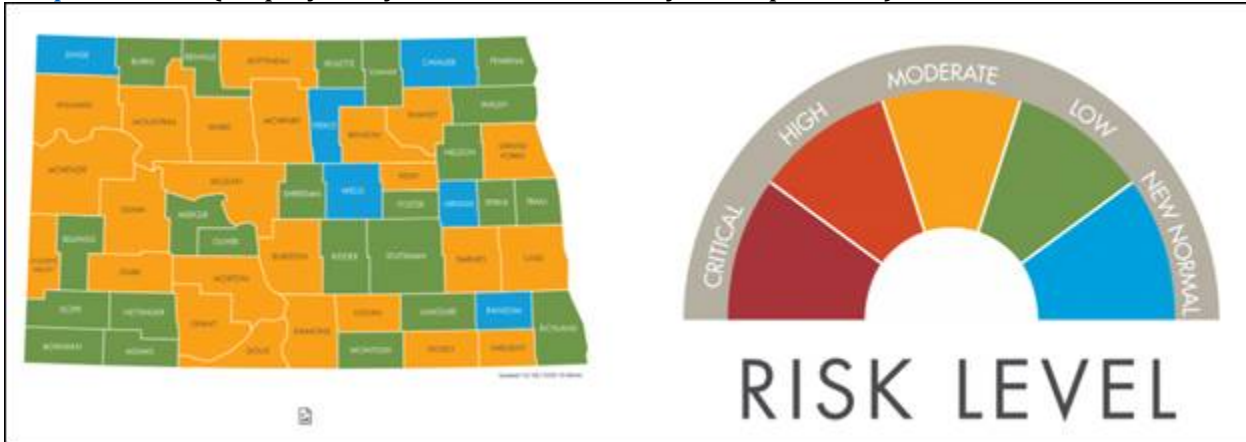


Good Afternoon –

As of today, October 8, 2020 the NDDoH has shifted **Richland County's** (Wahpeton, ND) risk level to Low (**Green**); **Cass County** (Fargo, ND) continues to be at Moderate (**Yellow**).

- **Fargo:** **Sunday, October 11** from 1-5 p.m. at the **Shelly Ellig Indoor Track** at NDSU, located at 1625 14th St. N. (directly west of the Sanford Health Athletic Complex)
- **Wahpeton:** **Monday, October 12** from 11:30 a.m.-3 p.m. at the Harry Stern and Ella Stern **Cultural Center** (Wahpeton) – this building is on the Northeast side of the oval between the Hektner Student Center and Old Main.
