Storage for book/supplies overstock is scattered throughout the campus. Construction for the Bookstore and Mail Center are looking to begin in April, ending in June. Their goal is to be back up and running in August of 2021.
- Dining Rates Karen Bajumpaa, Assistant Director for Dining Services
  - Rates will increase 1.2-1.4%. Rates will stay the same for students who 0 sign up for the Stay and Save program. Hours of operation will be reviewed again for next year. Hot meals have been a great addition to grab and go and we plan to continue this. Noticed an increase in the number of students using their dining plan in the Wild Grounds Café. Next semester students may use their meal plan to get a coffee. Looking into starting up the ice cream, waffle, and pizza option in the Flickertail Dining Room again. The specialty bar is undetermined at this moment. Dining services hired sous chef, Carly. Continuing on working on disinfecting process to be faster and more efficient. The Plains Room will be available to dine in until March when the bookstore will transfer there for their remodel. Fall 2021 expecting to have regular dishware instead of disposable. Culinary Arts are using the Wild Ground Café on Tuesday and Thursday for their 6<sup>th</sup> Street Eatery Restaurant. Carly is setting up an Instagram account to reach students more. We are working on the GET mobile app, which will show students dining services information regarding their meal plan. This app also allows students to request a meal ahead of time. Dining Services employs 18 students at this moment. Looking into getting nutritional information this summer.
- Housing Rates Melissa Johnson, Exec. Director for Student and Residential Life

 Dining Rates will increase by 3% for students for the next academic year. This rate increase is needed for structural updates and personnel costs. There are yearly costs such as \$150,000 for annual maintenance, \$220,000 deferred maintencance, a \$575,000 for an annual bond payment from the Forkner and Riley Hall renovations, and an anticipated 2-3% increase in personal costs. There is a \$2,099,250 total for deferred maintenance at this moment. It will cost an estimate of \$1,500,000 to raze McMahon/Satterlee/Babcock. This is not an urgency but a necessity down the road. Looking at what has been improved, updated plumbing and flooring in units NW/SE came up to \$107,750. Renovation to the Schultz Hall bathrooms came to \$20,000. Nordgaard Hall had \$1,065,000 in improvements.

    - The NDSWAPS Survey is administered during Fall 2020. There were 225 students who participated. Survey is used for many events planned through the year. Slight increase in alcohol use weekly and annually. Underage usage is higher than average for NDUS System schools. Cannabis use has decreased slightly in the last year. A high amount of students believe that alcohol and cannabis are not needed for to have a good time. Alcohol, e-cig, and vaping have slightly increased since 2018. Cannabis is about the same as 2018. ATOD prevention team encourage parents to talk to their student to enhance ATOD education/awareness. It was told by the students that the influence of their parents made a big difference in whether they used alcohol, tobacco, or other drugs. Concerns of cannabis legalization could cause an increase in usage. The increase in vaping is also a growing concern for NDSCS.
    - Vince Plummer discussed mental health and well-being. With COVID-19 there is an increase in feeling nervous, anxious, or on edge. Same with feeling down and depressed. Increase in major depressive disorder and generalized or social anxiety disorder were the highest concerns. Slight increase of self-injurious thoughts and behaviors. Protective factors of having someone to share concerns with is high whether it be someone on/off campus, family/friends, or staff/faculty. There is mental health wellness promotion through the NDSCS website, videos, oval signage, tabling, permanent decision posters, mental health minute, "what to do" residence hall cards. There is suicide awareness training for RA's along side other student and employee trainings. There are several interventions on campus. Essentia Health comes in to help prescribe medications for students for free. Medications are not free but the doctor visit is.

Students on average have about 7 hrs of sleep for the majority, a smaller minority claimed they received less. It was reported in the survey that 7.1% of firearms are stored on campus.
