



# How to Apply for Exemption from the On-Campus Living Policy

To apply for exemption from living on campus online, please complete the following steps.

1. Go to NDSCS homepage at [www.ndscs.edu](http://www.ndscs.edu) and select Campus Connection.




2. Log into Campus Connection.







**Once you select your campus, you will be directed to login again using your campus credentials.**




