- Will be registered as a full-time undergraduate student in an accredited North Dakota university, college or vocational/technical certification program.
(Full-time status is determined by the criteria of the institution.)
- Previous NDACo Scholarship winners may not apply.

REQUIRED MATERIALS

- This form, fully completed, signed and dated by student applicant.
- A resume or listing of work experience, volunteerism, awards/recognition, etc.
- TWO (2) letters of recommendation, dated within the past 12 months.
- Personal statement about your academic goals and expectations. (limit 300 words)
- Essay that answers the question, "How has your parent's/grandparent's experience in county government helped shape who you are?" (limit 300 words)
- A transcript (sealed) from the high school or college most recently attended.
